Hosts for tonight's meeting Ryan From and Lou Fini are from Medtronic, Physio-Control. They presented the LUCAS Device – an automated CPR compression device. A demonstration was given on a manikin. The capabilities of this device depend on the chest height of the patient **rather** than age or weight. The range of chest height for the use of this device is from a minimum of 7.5" to a maximum of 11.9". It will do 100 impressions/min. at a compression depth of 2". It costs approximately \$14,500 and comes with a 2 yr. Warranty. The company offers a 90 day trial.

Also demonstrated was the new Life Pak 15. Lou Fini showed durability of this new version of the Life Pak. The Life Pak 15 is still awaiting approval for sale.

Then go to Tools, click on Options, click Advanced, click Update and you will see 3 boxes – they should **not** be checked.
